The optimism and hope presented at the Polish Pavilion showcased the finest Poland offered in the arts, crafts, agriculture, sciences, and commerce. With the outbreak of World War II and the closing of the World's Fair in 1940, the artifacts presented at the Polish Pavilion could not return to Poland.
